Staging:

- For groups exceeding 100 guests, staging is very strongly recommended.
- If the height of the stage is more than 12", steps are required on each side of the stage to enable guests to come on stage.
- If a DJ will also be present, we request they set up their equipment off stage to keep the stage clear and uncluttered for the performance.
- The stage/performance area must be free of all obstacles, including, but not limited to, musical equipment, lecturns, podiums, disc jockey equipment, excessive stage decorations, etc. This is for the safety of the volunteers.

Electrical/PA

- An electrical outlet or powered, grounded extension coard within twenty feet of the performance space.
- Any cabling on the stage floor MUST be securely taped down with duct tape in order to prevent trip hazards.
- PA is provided for up to 300 people. For larger audiences, a line-in to the house system is required.

Room Layout:

- Plan the room layout so that guests are seated "10 and 2" on an imaginary clock. In other words, avoid placing any tables to the extreme sides or behind the performance area.
- Performance area must be at least 8' x 4', uncluttered, and be sufficiently lit.
- There MUST be NO "Dead Zone," or empty space between the stage and the audience. (IE: No 'dance floor' in front of the stage.)
- If round tables are used, we highly recommend you request them to be "cresent set" to ensure all seated guests can comfortably see the stage

Eating & Drinking:

- Performance must not be scheduled during dinner.
- The performance should take place after dinner. The ideal time is after the plates have been cleared, and after coffee has been served.
- Clearing, drink refreshment by the wait staff and other services should not take place during the performance.

Venue access:

- We require access to the venue a minimum of 60 minutes before any guests are due to arrive.
- No Load-In assistance is required.
